

## **CODE OF ETHICS AGREEMENT**

## DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING INDUSTRY CONSULTANT

## Please initial each ethics statement to signify agreement and compliance forthwith:

Ensure that all consultants and/or their employees behave in a professional manner in
communications with employers, drug free workplace service agents, regulatory officials, attorneys
and industry associations.
Maintain the highest standards of practice and perform all professional functions with
honesty and integrity. Refrain from engaging in any practice where there is price gouging or where
pricing is "set or fixed" by one or more Consultants meant to remove competitive pricing practices.
Objectively deal with all aspects of Drug Free WorkPlace (DFWP) testing programs. For
workplace drug testing, recommend the testing process include lab confirmation testing when
applicable along with review and verification by a Medical Review Officer (MRO).
Maintain professional practice standards and appropriate application of federal, state, or
local regulations, statutes, case law or directives in providing drug and alcohol testing consulting
services to employers, attorneys, DFWP service agents, and industry associations.
Demonstrate a commitment to the development and maintenance of professiona
competence and knowledge and participation in drug and alcohol industry associations.
Respect all DFWP program participants and their rights. Respect all stakeholders in DFWP
administration, including other Consultants and industry service agents and refrain from unethical
business and marketing practices. Protect confidential information and ensure it is handled in
accordance with existing laws, regulations, and contractual requirements.
Consultant's Ethics Statement: Workplace drug testing affects the livelihood of job applicants and
employees; thus, ethical conduct and confidentiality are critical functions of the Consultant's
operation. If the Consultant is unsure of how to advise a client in a particular situation, the
Consultant must be willing to seek the counsel of others with expertise in that area. The Consultant
and/or staff must know the difference between right and wrong. A Consultant's mantra is to take

responsibility for mistakes or errors, find the root cause, resolve the issue, and take steps to ensure	ire
the issue does not continue to occur. Respect for team members, customers, vendors, and	
competitors is a core value for integrity in the drug and alcohol testing industry. The Accredited	
Consultant shall abide by this current published NDASA Consultant code of ethics.
